This is the 27th Celebrate Festival and our principles remain the same. We bring together a wide range of community partners in Whalley Range to put on an exciting day of free activities celebrating the very best of our fantastic community with a focus on fun, creativity and well-being, whilst looking at serious issues. In the run up to the event we run workshops and pop up events in schools and community spaces to develop creative ideas.

Immerse yourself in **Lotte Karlsen's** captivating "**Oceanic Currents**" installation, where turquoise fabric panels suspended from trees undulate like flowing kelp, evoking Japanese artistic traditions in its representation of the perpetual currents driving our world's oceans.

Carrie Williams ran a vocal workshop with Montessori House. JNR8 hosted kazoo and fairy making with Mez from Mad Sustainable Designs, banner making with Freya Wysocki, messages in water with Lotte Karlsen, a guitar workshop with John Diver and collage making with Hollie from Jive Prints, who also ran a session for Whalley Range Women's Group. JNR8 also welcomed Chloe Fisher's chair yoga and mindfulness, a concert by the Happy Tuesdays and a Let's Talk Clean Air banner making workshop at Leg Up club. Big Bike Revival ran two Fix and Ride bike sessions in Manley Park.

Pop up gigs included Kuumba Jam, Sax in the Street, Vibe Bombing with the Alex Park Drummers and the Manley Park School Steel Band Procession around the park on Friday 7th June at 3pm.

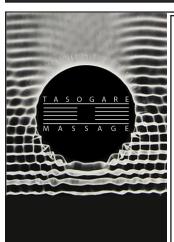
